

HEALTH/RISK PRESCREENING BEFORE ENTERING

We are responsible for creating a safe environment for parishioners and staff as we carry out the work of the Lord, and we need your help to do so.

To successfully pass this screening, a person must be able to answer “No” to all six of these questions. A “Yes” to even one question is a failed screening, and for the love and safety of your brothers and sisters, you are asked to return home immediately.

In the last 14 days, have you:

1. Been exposed to a person with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 without the correct PPE?
2. Had a temperature at least 100.4°F or 1.8°F above a lower regular personal baseline temperature?
3. Had new or increased shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
4. Had a new cough?
5. Had at least two of the following symptoms together:
 - Chills
 - Muscle pain
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - Runny nose/congestion
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Diarrhea
 - Vomiting
 - Fatigue
