



Is your family interested in exploring the possibility of becoming a Catholic? You are welcome to join our RCIA classes.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) provides a forum for shared spiritual growth and a means to explore the Catholic Christian tradition through Scripture, sacraments, Church teaching and social outreach, all in the midst of the Catholic faith community. Formation includes several areas:

- **Scripture** — The stories of God's people
- **Teaching** — What Catholics believe
- **Prayer** — How we communicate with God
- **Liturgy** — How the community worships
- **Mission** — How we live out what we believe

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) is for you if you are:

- An adult or child who has reached the age of reason (7yrs or older)
- Unbaptized and want to become Catholic Christian through the sacrament of baptism, confirmation and Eucharist
- Baptized Christian (in another faith tradition or Catholic) and want full sacramental membership in the Roman Catholic Church through confirmation and Eucharist
- Attending a Catholic Church because of a loved one or spouse and are not sure if the Catholic Church is for you but are willing to ask questions.

Children and adults who opt to begin the process meet once a week and attend Sunday Mass. Those who are ready to make the commitment to become members of the Catholic Church usually do so at the Easter Vigil.
