

A Letter from Principal Anna Horton

The theme for the 2024–25 school year was “One in the Spirit.”

Together, we turned to the Holy Spirit for unity and guidance as we navigated a year of pastoral transition—one filled with faith, hope, and peace.

In 2025–26, we welcomed our new Pastor, Father Phuong, and our new Parochial Vicar, Father Tim. At the same time, we advanced our accreditation goals, adopted a new reading curriculum, and continued our work on the Partners in the Gospel strategic planning initiative.

Caring for our aging campus remained a priority. This past fiscal year, we undertook significant planning to replace our school’s heating system with an efficient electric heat pump. As part of that process, we installed a new backup boiler this summer. Other improvements included new bathroom stall dividers, refinished school and gym floors, new student cubbies, and expanded storage throughout the building. We also upgraded our phone and alarm systems, added a shade sail to the preschool playground, and deep-cleaned and sealed bathroom, stair, and classroom floors. An older building requires consistent tending, and we remain committed to being good stewards of the resources entrusted to us.

We also continued to make strides in staff compensation, working to bring our salaries closer in line with neighboring schools. We recognize that both campus upkeep and competitive compensation affect tuition and parish giving, and directly impact your family. We are deeply grateful for your partnership, your generosity, and your commitment to this community.

Holy Rosary School continues to thrive as the largest ministry of Holy Rosary Parish. Last year, we had the privilege of serving more than 500 students. We are honored to form both the minds and spirits of the children attending our school. It is our prayer that their strong academic foundation, combined with formation as disciples of Christ, equips them to live out Catholic social teaching and bring hope and light to the world.

Thank you for accompanying us each day and for your prayers for our community. Our students ended the year strong in virtue and with the joyful awareness that when we are One in the Spirit with others, we grow in faith ourselves.
